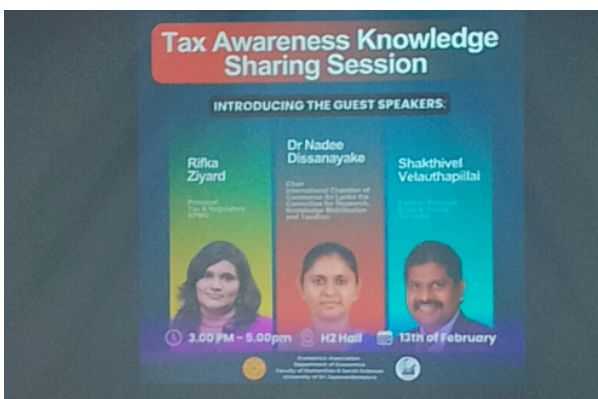


Educating Youth on Taxation



The Committee for Research, Knowledge Mobilization, and Taxation (RKMT) of the International Chamber of Commerce Sri Lanka (ICCSL) recently organized an enlightening educational program for undergraduates at the University of Sri Jayewardenepura. The program aimed to empower youth about taxation to improve compliance and boost government revenue. Coordinated by Professor B. W. R. Damayanthi and

guided by Professor K. G. G. Weerasinghe, the event insightful discussions led by experts, including RKMT Chair Dr. Nadee Dissanayake and tax professionals Ms Rifka Ziyad (KPMG) and Mr Velauthapillai Shakhthivel (Ernst & Young). Key topics covered included tax registration, taxpayer rights and obligations, and current tax laws. The program included pre-and post-assessments to measure its effectiveness. The RKMT advocates for incorporating taxation into higher education curricula to promote a culture of compliance in Sri Lanka. The initiative received positive feedback, and there are plans to expand it to other universities to cultivate a more informed and responsible taxpayer base among future generations. This event took place on 13th February 2025.



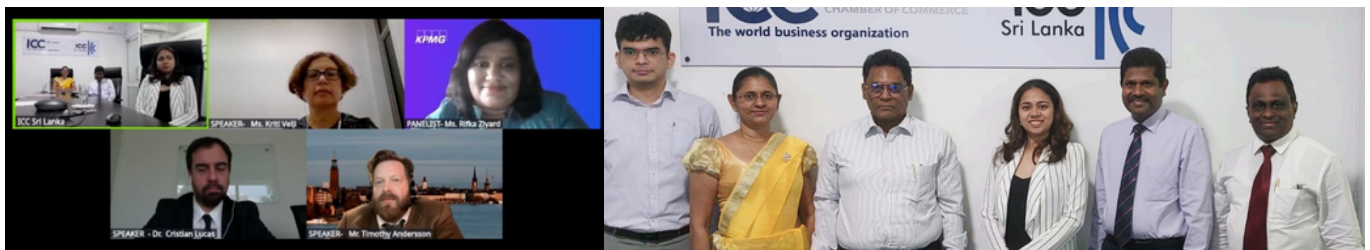

Research Survey on Taxpayer Awareness

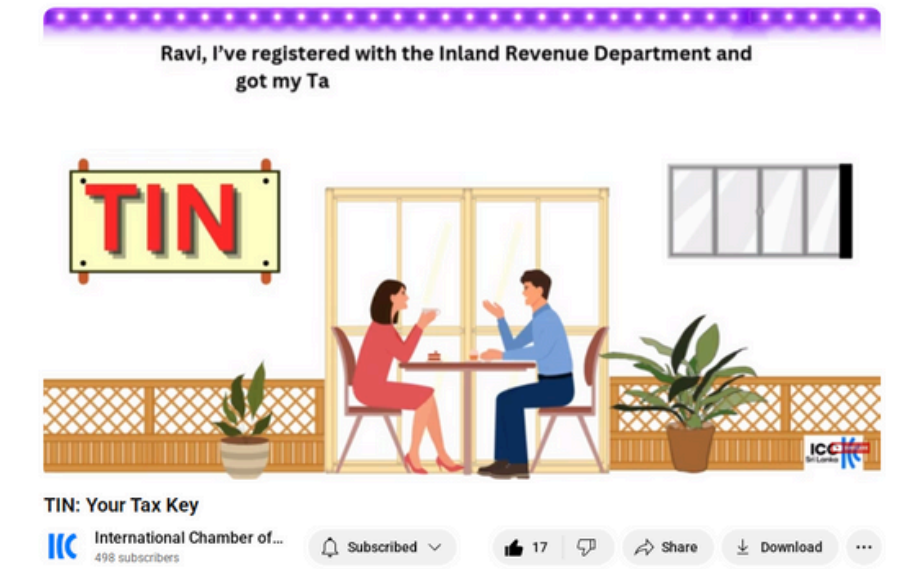
